Updates from the Community Greenhouse

The greenhouse tomato plants are getting huge! Hopefully we will see a few tomatoes at the BAC Farmers Market by the middle of July. Unfortunately a small critter nibbled the tops off the cucumbers though...

All of the tables are mostly empty, with everyone's plants in the ground. To the south of the greenhouse, we have developed 5 new garden plots with nicely formed beds, and several summer crops. This year, a local farmer, Andy Chae, who manages Fisheye Farms, helped shape the beds and will be raising some of his crops here in exchange for the fantastic work he did.

In subsequent years, anyone who is interested in practicing managing a small market garden can sign up to plant these beds. There will be free table space in the greenhouse to start transplants for the beds, and other grower amenities will be provided. In exchange, that grower will help with basic greenhouse maintenance and watering. For someone who lacks ex-

perience and land this could be a great opportunity to incubate a small business and gain skills in a low-risk, supportive setting.

This year though, Andy will be tending the beds. If you see him out there be sure to say hello.
